Willingness to carry out research projects under the guidance of a project manager and independently obtain funding from external sources.</li><li>5. Fluent knowledge of the English language (C1 / B2).</li><li>6. Willingness to undertake scientific, teaching and organizational work for Poznan University of Physical Education.</li><li>7. #### Information Clause for the Candidate

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (General Data Protection Regulation, OJ EU L 119/1 of 4 May 2016), we inform you that:

Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of conducting the recruitment process for the position specified in the announcement, and if necessary, for the establishment, exercise, or defense of potential legal claims related to the recruitment process. In this respect, we will process your data based on our legitimate interest, which is the ability to assert or defend against claims in proceedings before courts or public authorities.

4. The recipients of your personal data will be authorized employees of the Controller.
5. Your personal data will be processed for the duration of the recruitment process for the position specified in the announcement, but no longer than 60 days from the date of publication of the announcement. If you give your consent to participate in future recruitment processes, your data will be stored for no longer than 180 days from the date of publication.
